Instructional Related Activities (IRA) Education Code 89230

"Instructionally related activities" means those activities and laboratory experiences that are at least partially sponsored by an academic discipline or department and that are, in the judgment of the president of a particular campus, with the approval of the trustees, integrally related to its formal instructional offerings.

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What activities does IRA fund?

- Debate competitions
- Class field trips
- Senior project supplies (for example, ME, ET, GSMA)
- Intercollegiate athletics
- Music and dance performance
- Art exhibits
- Other activities associated with instructional areas, consistent educational code 89230

IRA Committee Funding Priorities

- Eliminate out-of-pocket expenses for curriculumrelated activities
- Diversity of program activities
- Greater numbers of students involved

Proposed fee increase – who decides?

- IRA is a CAT II fee, a campus-based mandatory fee required for enrollment
- Chancellor approves establishment
- Presidents approve changes
- Fee Referendum or Alternative Consultation for all changes expected

IRA Fee Increase Proposal

- Proposed change:
 - FY23-24 IRA fee increase of \$30 23.1%
 - FY24-25 IRA fee increase of \$30 18.8%
 - Annual HEPI* adjustments thereafter

*HEPI = Higher Ed Price Index

Why should IRA fee be increased?

- Less funding currently available for spring semester activities
- Not currently fully funding all qualified applications
- Inflation has eroded purchasing power, esp. recently
- IRA has not increased in 16 years
