## How to Read the Fall 2008 Enrollment Report

### Definitions

EMPL are “employees” who are registered for classes

TRANS are “transitory students”, i.e. international exchange students and visiting cruise students who are not in a CMA degree program.

2008 are students in the Class of 2008 (or earlier) who have not yet graduated and are completing classes to obtain their degree

2009 are students in the Class of 2009, i.e. Seniors

2010 are students in the Class of 2010, i.e. Juniors

2011 are students in the Class of 2011, i.e. Sophomores

2012 are students in the Class of 2012, i.e. Freshmen
