National Cargo Bureau (NCB) was incorporated as a non-profit organization, with a mission of "Safety of Life and Cargo at Sea", in May of 1952 and began its actual operation on November 19 of the same year. The Bureau was formed from the inspection divisions of the Board of Underwriters of New York and the Board of Marine Underwriters of San Francisco and now operates on a nationwide basis.

NCB was launched in 1952 after a series of maritime disasters demonstrated a need for uniform standards and regulations. Those disasters included the capsizing of grain ships due to shifting of cargoes, shipboard fires relating to wet cotton or metal turnings, and an ammonium nitrate ship explosion at Texas City, Texas in 1947.

Since inception, NCB's role has grown in many areas. The U.S. Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) contains several references to NCB in Titles 7, 19, and 46 as well as in the Hazmat Regulations under Title 49. By assignment and under the authority of the United States Coast Guard, the certificates issued by National Cargo Bureau, may be accepted as prima facie evidence of compliance with the provisions of the Dangerous Cargo Act, bulk solid cargo transport regulations and the rules and regulations for Bulk Grain Cargo.

NCB surveys are performed at the request of industry. If deficiencies are noted during inspections, NCB works with the client to address them. NCB considers all surveys to be confidential and does not share information unless directed to do so by the party requesting the survey. NCB is not an enforcement agency.

NCB presently has 18 offices located nationwide, providing coverage for all major U.S. ports. These operations may be supplemented globally by trusted network partners vetted and approved by NCB.

Marine surveyors employed by NCB include licensed ex-mariners with broad experience in all manner of cargo and vessel surveys. Staff experience and expertise is enhanced and maintained by a robust internal training regimen.
