Edwards Leadership Program

COVID Booster Requirement and Reporting

Per the new <u>CSU COVID policy</u>, "fully vaccinated" is now defined as having received your most recent vaccination or booster within the last six months. Log into your PeopleSoft account and select "CSU COVID19 Self Certification" under Self Service to upload your proof of vaccination. If you still need to get your booster, search for <u>local vaccination sites</u> or make a Friday or Saturday appointment at the Solano County <u>Mass Vaccination Clinic</u> to get your booster.

2022-23 Financial Aid and Scholarships

To be eligible for financial aid – grants, scholarships, and loans – at Cal Maritime, you need to complete **annually** the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Even if you are receiving aid in the current academic year, you will need to complete a new FAFSA every year. The 2022-23 FAFSA application will be based on 2020 tax year information. For more information and to start your application now, visit the <u>FAFSA website</u>. Do not wait until the March 2 deadline, because you will miss institutional aid opportunities!

The <u>Cal Maritime Foundation Scholarship Application</u> for 2022-23 is now available and the deadline is February 15, 2022. With the consolidated application, all that is required is to submit essays in response to three questions. These essays should be thoughtful, well-constructed, and represent your value as a member of the Cal Maritime community. The Scholarship Committee considers the essays, cumulative GPA, major, and financial need when selecting recipients of the scholarships. Applicants must be current Cal Maritime students who are returning for the fall 2022 semester.
