

EOP Peer Mentor

Compensation: \$14.50/hour

- Meet with mentees monthly during the academic year to offer advice, academic guidance, campus resources, and social support.
- Communicate with mentees individually, including introductory correspondence in the summer months. Serve as a general resource to answer mentees' questions and support students' experiences, concerns, struggles, and successes.
- Ensure that mentees are aware of and have access to EOP resources.
- Refer students to the next level support services when appropriate.
- Serve as a liaison to EOP professional staff in communicating student needs and suggestions.
- Meet regularly as a peer mentoring team to discuss best practices, share feedback, and plan activities for EOP cadets.
- Serve as the lead on a minimum of one EOP event each semester, completing planning paperwork in a timely manner and working with EOP staff to carry out the event.
- Participate in 2 to 3 EOP activities each semester, including workshops, social events, etc.
- Participate in a new mentoring orientation training.
- Participate in critical EOP programming/ events (Summer Bridge, All Hands events, etc.).

Compensation: \$15.00/hour

- All duties pertaining to an EOP Peer Mentor
